However, by the following week, his bruises still had not healed, plus red spots were appearing under his eyes. His pediatrician referred him to Nemours.

During his 10 months of chemotherapy, Brett faced many challenges, from steroid-induced diabetes to extreme weight loss and a septic infection that led to pneumonia. But through it all, he stayed strong and even kept up with his studies by taking online classes.
